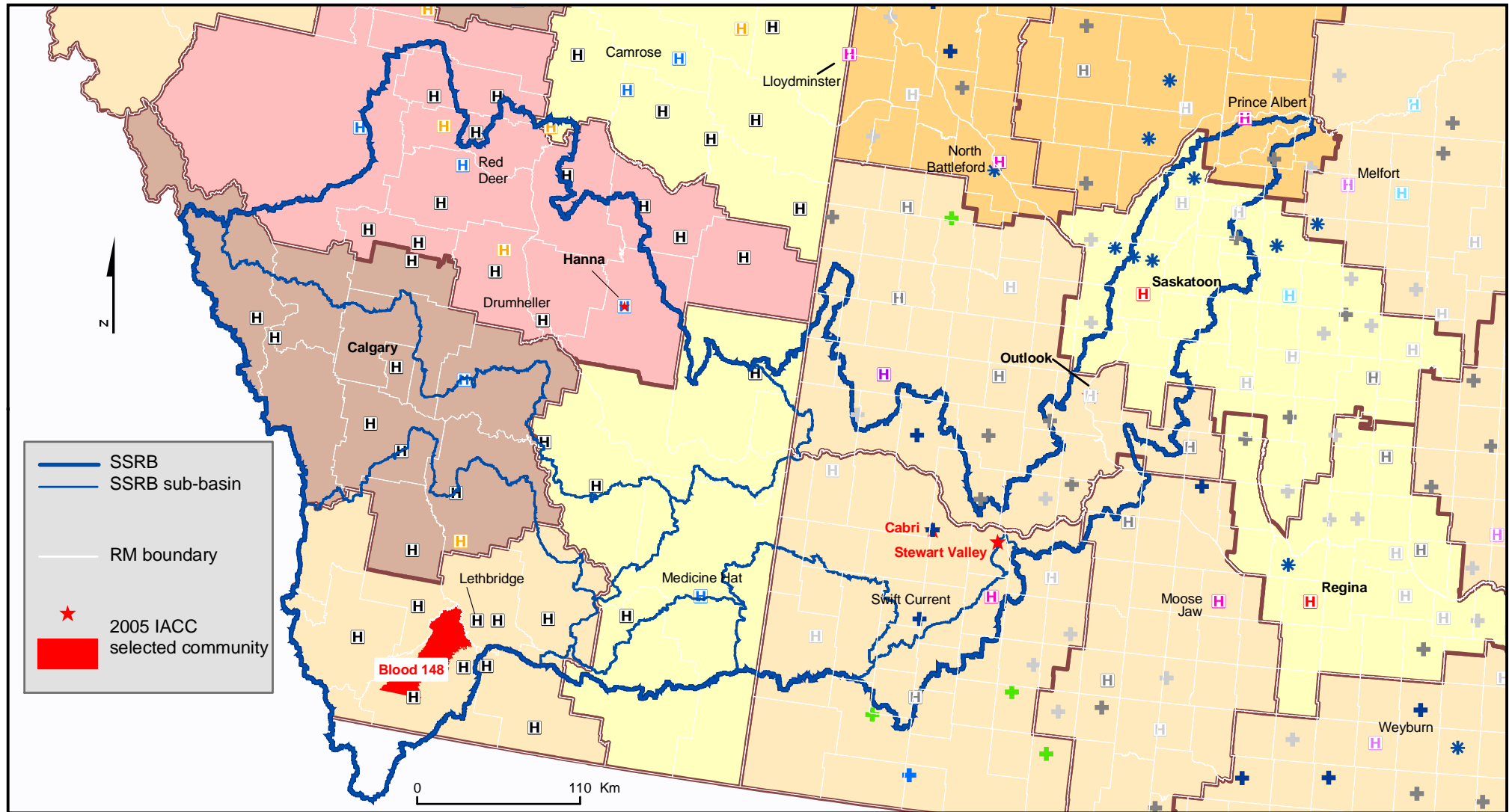


Health Care Provision in the South Saskatchewan River Basin (SSRB).

Alberta Registered Hospitals

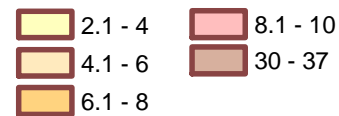
- General and auxiliary hospital
